

Galen University's new **PROFESSIONAL MASTER'S OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (PMBA)** is breaking new barriers for the delivery of graduate education in Belize. This program offers students the distinctive opportunity to complete a graduate degree in **fourteen months**.

The PMBA program is specifically designed for professionals with a minimum of two years working experience, who have completed studies in Business Administration or related fields at the undergraduate level with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Galen's PMBA program emphasizes applied learning and utilizes the Harvard Business School case study method in most of the courses. The cases:

- portray real events
 - immerse students in the challenges they are expected to face
 - require thoughtful analyses with limited or even insufficient information
 - require effective responses within ambiguous circumstances or complex economic and political contexts
 - demand decisive action that must be articulated among other talented, ambitious individuals

Financing Options

Full Payment Upfront: Students receive a 10% discount when full payment is made at the beginning of the program (cost per credit hour \$495). The total tuition cost is \$16,335.

Installment Payment Plan: Payments of \$1296.42 are paid on a monthly basis over a period of 14 months. The total tuition cost is \$18,150.

The PMBA offers a **high quality curriculum** on a Wednesday night and an all-day Saturday format in Belize City. This delivery method requires students to commit to intensive coursework, with time off for holidays. This innovative program consist of eleven courses delivered in a sequence (cohort), with each course lasting five weeks. All students are required to move directly from one course to another.
